PROCEDURES FOR SIGN UP TABLE

PROCEDURES FOR MISSIONARY CARDS

Prayer and Greeting Cards of encouragement are sent monthly to the Overseas Missionaries, and Seminary Students (if any), supported by Grace Presbyterian Church. Circles are assigned specific months and recipients.

IMPORTANT: It is critical that the cards going to the Overseas Missionaries have no Religious Markings or Stickers and <u>do not</u> show any return address or indication on the envelopes that they are coming from a church.
